

SCAT Test

Students who have taken the SCAT test receive TWO (2) grades that correspond to the two parts of the test: language (verbal) & mathematics (quantitative).

If these grades are equal to or above the bases shown below, then the student has passed the exams and gained access to the CTY Greece programs. The cut off points are formed based on class grade.

Students may pass one of the two parts of the test or both. This fact does not affect the accessibility to the CTY Greece programs but differentiates the type of courses that can be chosen.

More specifically:

- If the student has passed the language part (verbal) of the SCAT test, he/she can participate in humanities courses.

- If the student has passed the mathematical part (quantitative) of the SCAT test, he/she can participate in science courses.

- If the student has passed both parts, he/she can participate in all courses offered by CTY Greece for his/her age.

STB Test

Students who have taken the STB test get ONE (1) grade. If this score is equal to or above the bases shown below, then the student has passed the exams and gained access to the CTY Greece programs. The cut off points are formed based on class grade.

Students who have passed the STB test can participate in STEM courses.
